| <p>1. Provide a mechanism for communication & collaboration among all bicycle stakeholders in the Centre Region</p> | <p>This is a primary continuing mission for CRBAC.</p> |
| <p>2. Provide support & encouragement to increase the number of Bicycle Friendly Businesses (BFBs) and to improve Bicycle Friendly Community (BFC) and Bicycle Friendly University (BFU) status to silver or gold</p> | <p>Both BFC and BFU re-applications are due this year. Assistance for BFC applications is currently spearheaded by CentreBike and ActiveLions with CRBAC support.</p> |
| <p>3. Assist municipalities in adopting and executing recommendations from the regional bicycle master plan</p> | <p>There are many items that will require municipal actions, including development of bicycle routes, adoption of complete streets ordinances, etc.</p> |
| <p>4. Support action initiatives of CentreBike, State College Cycling, and Nittany Mountain Biking Association (NMBA)</p> | <p>These organizations have had representatives at CRBAC meetings, resulting in broader support for many initiatives.</p> |
| <p>5. Assist PSU & municipal police forces in establishing a fair and effective system for citations and education regarding bicycle safety</p> | <p>Bicycle Education & Enforcement Program (BEEP) may be adopted this year. It is one example of improved methods for enforcement and education.</p> |
| <p>6. Promote transportation incentives for biking to work</p> | <p>Information has been gathered and a meeting is scheduled for late Feb 2016 among PSU and CentreBike representatives.</p> |
| <p>7. Continue to support bicycle component in Drivers Ed classes and to expand to other school districts.</p> | <p>Kelly Doyle and SCASD participants are continuing to evaluate and improve the teaching modules. Active Lions have also volunteered to assist with this.</p> |
| <p>8. Promote State College as a tourist destination and walkable community for bicycle enthusiasts and those new to the biking</p> | <p>The Nittany Stage Race is a good example of the types of event programming and messaging as part of this activity. Connections could be made with the Visitor's Bureau to further these efforts.</p> |
