Tour gives Centre County residents the opportunity to learn about solar energy

April 30, 2024 (STATE COLLEGE, PA) [Solar United Neighbors](#) (SUN) with its local partners is hosting a Solar Tour in Centre County on Saturday, May 18, 2024 from 11:00 AM – 1:00 PM. This event is free and open to all community members in Centre County. Visitors have the chance to stop by one or several of the solar powered homes, each coupled with an electric or hybrid vehicle and other unique technologies.

The solar tour will let people across the county learn about solar technology and the process of going solar. “Talking with current solar owners, learning about their experience, and knowing how much money they save each month is the best way to determine if solar is right for you and your family.” said Monica Carey, Solar United Neighbors Pennsylvania Director. “If you’re even a bit curious about solar energy, join us for this tour.”

The Solar Tour includes 8 homes in the following neighborhoods: State College, Bellefonte, Port Matilda and Centre Hall.

The tour comes as the [Centre County 2024 Solar and EV Charger Co-op](#) is actively recruiting members. The co-op educates members about solar energy and helps them install solar on their home. The group is free to join and there’s no commitment to purchase a solar system. The group launched in March and is accepting new members through July 26, 2024.
