



## Bike Facilities

**COG Fleet Bicycles:** The CRPA prepared a grant application to Capitol Blue Cross for the purchase of two fleet bicycles, lights, helmets, and locks. In 2018, \$1,000 was awarded to COG for the purchase. The bikes will be utilized by COG staff for short-distance work-related trips. This investment is one step in COG's plan to apply in 2019 for Bicycle Friendly Business (BFB) designation from the League of American Bicyclists.

**Bike Education:** The Centre Region was redesignated a Bronze Level Bicycle Friendly Community in October 2016. The designation recognizes the Centre Region's commitment to improving conditions for bicycling through investments in bicycling promotion, education programs, infrastructure, and pro-bicycling policies. In an effort to provide more bike education programs in the Region, CRPA partnered with Centre Region Parks and Recreation (CRPR) to increase the number of bicycle education classes in 2018. The classes covered a range of topics, including a learn to ride class for toddlers, street skills classes for adults, and Biking in the Centre Region 101, which familiarized attendees with bicycle facilities in the Centre Region and local and state laws. Classes were also offered on bike touring, mountain biking, bike maintenance, and electronic bike (e-bikes).
