



Bulk Waste Collection Guidelines

- **Properly prepare the items;** follow the instructions in this list.
- **Furniture:** make sure 2 workers could lift it.
- **Bedding:** keep it dry.
- **Appliances:** remove doors; limit 1 each type.
- **Electronics** (picked up in separate truck) limit of 2 televisions
- **Wood/old lumber:** cut to 4' length; tie in bundles or place in can.
- **Tires:** limit 6; 20" diameter (passenger car tires), remove rim
- **Carpeting**—dry, rolled and tied, cut in 4' lengths.
- **Glass panes:** must be heavily taped or sealed in a box.
- **Homeowner-generated small project construction materials;** bag or bundle.
- **Electronics, appliances, and tires must be separated from other bulk waste**
- **All refuse from your property only.**
- **Loose piles of anything** (such as debris, wood, leaves, grass, soil/dirt)
- **Items too heavy or large** for 2 workers to lift
- **Items that cannot fit** in the collection truck or that will damage it; (hot tubs, furnaces, cast iron items, pianos, organs, trailer/boat hitches, large trampolines, boats and canoes)
- **Liquid paints and solvents, batteries**
- **Unbundled wood/lumber, branches or brush**
- **Concrete, bricks, stones**
- **Railroad ties**
- **Propane tanks**
- **Dead animals**
- **Tires bigger than 20"** diameter (tractor, racing, etc.) or more than 6 tires
- **Contractor-generated material**
- **Electronics or tires** buried beneath or behind a bulk pile
- **Items from other properties**

GENERAL GUIDELINES AND LIMITS

Guidelines

- **All items must be at the curb by 7am** on your regular trash collection day, including customers with door service. **Bulk items will not be collected at the door.**
- **Do not use cardboard boxes** as containers. They're not sturdy to start with and when they get wet, they get flimsy. Soggy boxes will not be collected.
- Garbage bags containing wet or very heavy materials can break when lifted, so these will not be collected.
- **Use multiple containers** instead of overfilling a container. Overfilled containers will not be collected.
- **If items** such as wheelbarrows, flower pots, tarps and bicycles are near the bulk waste pile, they will be taken too.
- Recyclables, including covered electronics, appliances and tires, **must be separate** from other bulk waste.

Limits

- **Tires:** limit of 6 tires
- **Appliances:** limit of 1 of each type of appliance
- **Televisions:** limit of 2
- **Nothing longer than 6';** cut wood, lumber, and carpeting into 4' lengths
- **Wood:** nothing bigger than 4" diameter

Materials and items will NOT be collected from trailers or truck beds.
