Purpose of the Public Meeting

The Centre County Metropolitan Planning Organization (CCMPO) is considering the addition of \$20 million to the 2019-2022 TIP for the Preliminary Engineering (PE) Phase of the “State College Area Connector (SCAC)” project. The PE phase would include completion of a Planning and Environmental Linkage (PEL) process, and preliminary engineering/design work for improvements in the area of the Route 322/144/45 corridors.

No alternative improvements for the SCAC have been developed at this time. PennDOT would use the PEL process and preliminary engineering work to develop and evaluate alternatives, identify a preferred alternative, and obtain environmental clearance for the preferred alternative. The PEL process and preliminary engineering work would begin in early 2020.

PennDOT is also completing an update of data associated with traffic, safety, community and environmental features that was collected over 15 years ago for a previous project in this area, the South Central Centre County Transportation Study (SCCCTS). Information collected as part of the “Data Refresh” for the Route 322/144/45 corridors is also available for review at this meeting. Information from the Data Refresh will be utilized in the PEL process and preliminary engineering work.
