What do I do with...

Electronics?

Pennsylvania law mandates "Covered Devices" such as computers, TVs, and printers be recycled. They can be dropped off for recycling at the CCRRA. See our Electronics Recycling Guide.

Fluorescent Light Bulbs?

Compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs) can be recycled at Home Depot, Lowes and the CCRRA.

Why Recycle?

It's The Law

Pennsylvania Act 101 mandates recycling. State College Borough and the Townships of Benner, College, Ferguson, Harris and Patton have local ordinances that require residents to recycle.

Economics

Recycling saves money on disposal costs and produces jobs by manufacturing new products. In Centre County it costs \$70/ton to dispose of trash and \$20/ton to dispose of recyclables.

Conservation

Recycling conserves natural resources like aluminum, steel, trees and oil. It also reduces the amount of energy needed to produce new products and the amount of pollution that enters the environment.



Did you know? On a per ton basis, recycled waste sustains 15 times more jobs than land-filled waste.

Recycling Made Easy in 3 Simple Steps

Step 1 Set up an indoor collection container.

Choose a container for your recycling needs (spare trash can, laundry basket, tote bag, large bucket).

Step 2 Place all of your recyclables in your collection container.

Separate **paper and paperboard, plastic bottles and jugs, metal cans and foils, and glass bottles and jars** from your trash and fill your indoor container with these accepted recyclables.

Corrugated cardboard is **not** accepted in blue carts. It may be recycled in a separate dumpster or at a drop off location.

Other miscellaneous plastics may be recycled at a drop off location.

Step 3 Empty your collection container in the appropriate blue carts

Place your properly sorted and clean recyclables in the appropriate blue carts.

- Plastic bottles and jugs
- Metal cans and foils
- Paper and paperboard
- Clear Glass
- Green Glass
- Brown Glass

If provided, place corrugated cardboard in the designated dumpster or recycle it at your nearest drop off location .

How to Prepare Recyclables

1. **All bottles, jars and cans must be rinsed and clean.**
2. **Do not break or crush glass bottles and jars.**
3. **Labels may stay on all products.**
4. **Do not put plastic or trash bags in the toters.**

Keep Your Recycling & Refuse Area Clean

1. **No broken glass, garbage, etc. may be placed on the ground.**
2. **If containers are overflowing, contact management to obtain more containers.**
3. **Keep motor vehicles and excess or bulk trash away from the blue toter**

Where can I recycle corrugated cardboard?

If your unit does not have a dumpster designated for corrugated cardboard, you may bring it to one of the drop off locations listed on the right. For a complete listing of all drop off locations, please check our website.

Steel & Aluminum Cans, Foil
Rinse and remove food residue.



PLASTIC

Bottles, Jugs & Jars
Rinse containers. Lids acceptable.



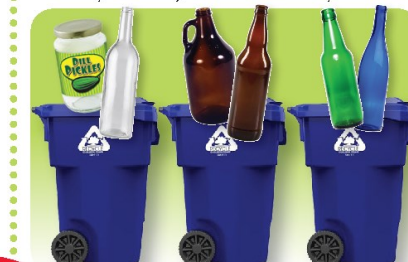
MIXED PAPER

Mixed Paper, Paperboard, Newspaper & Magazines
Bag shredded paper.



GLASS

Glass Bottles & Jars
Rinse containers. Separate by color. Lids acceptable.
