A RESOLUTION OF THE GENERAL FORUM OF THE CENTRE REGION COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS RECOMMENDING THE DESIGNATION OF MAY 2019 AS BIKE MONTH AND MAY 17, 2019 AS BIKE TO WORK DAY

WHEREAS, the CENTRE REGION COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS, Centre County, Pennsylvania, is a voluntary association of College, Ferguson, Harris, Halfmoon, and Patton Townships and State College Borough, collectively known as the Centre Region municipalities (MUNICIPALITIES) who joined together in 1969 to establish the Centre Region Council of Governments, Centre County, Pennsylvania; and,

WHEREAS, the Centre Region COG provides cooperative public services including, but not limited to, regional programs for parks and recreation, planning, transportation, code administration, fire protection, refuse collection and recycling, and library operations to the 96,000 residents who live in the MUNICIPALITIES; and,

WHEREAS, the Centre Region COG recognizes the benefits of bicycle and pedestrian commuting in providing exercise, decreasing air pollution, conserving fuel, decreasing traffic congestion, decreasing noise pollution, and improving the health of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Centre Region COG continues to work with the MUNICIPALITIES to plan facilities that promote bicycling and walking as means of transportation; and,

WHEREAS, the Centre Region COG was redesignated a Bronze Bicycle Friendly Community in October 2016 by the League of American Bicyclists; and,

WHEREAS, the Centre Region COG supports the efforts of CentreBike to promote bicycle commuting in the Centre Region, and,

WHEREAS, Centre Region COG is governed by the General Forum comprised of the 32 township/borough elected officials from the MUNICIPALITIES;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the General Forum of the Centre Region Council of Governments hereby:

1. Designates the month of May 2019 as Bike Month
2. Designates May 17, 2019 as Bike-to-Work Day
