### 4. REPORT FROM THE COORDINATOR

In addition to the working group, the CCSG met in executive session on the following dates, January 20 and February 4, 2026, to discuss legal items.

### 5. UPDATE ON THE PPA PROJECT

As discussed at the October 8, 2025, CCSG meeting, Prospect14 discussed with the group how federal actions and policies were influencing solar projects, which were impacting the overall economic feasibility of the solar PPA.

Mr. Shively, GreenSky Development Group, shared at the December 3, 2025, meeting:

The working group, along with the consultant, held numerous conversations with Prospect14 in an effort to understand the economic impact on our organizations.

Unfortunately, a collectively agreeable solution was not achieved that would alleviate the economic impact on Prospect14 while allowing the member organizations to achieve cost savings and price certainty through the PPA period.

Therefore, a mutual termination agreement is presented for each organization to consider in order to end their PPA agreement by the end of March.

### 6. CONSULTANT UPDATE

Mr. Gregg Shively, GreenSky Development Group, has indicated he will assist each organization in either terminating or continuing a relationship with NRG. Attached is a memo from Mr. Shively providing details on the process and options available to each organization. Mr. Shively will be present to answer any questions.

### 8. DRAFT AFTER-ACTION REPORT

The After-Action Report for the Power Purchase Agreement project is being drafted by the SPPA Working Group's Project Management Team. The team is working to present the report upon completion.
